

Mahowald Internship Program

The principal goal of the Mahowald Internship Program is to afford the student an opportunity to obtain career-building experiences and exposure to risk management services in a professional setting.

The student will acquire an understanding of the insurance industry and the role of an Insurance Agency. Throughout the internship the student will also be exposed to agency operational processes, and the organizational functions involved in providing exceptional client experiences. The position will be required to manage projects that will be implemented into agency operations. These projects will include guidance and feedback from an assigned mentor to enhance learning and development.

There is a dual responsibility for the successful outcomes of the internship. The student is highly encouraged and expected to identify their own objectives. The agency assigned mentor will provide the guidance and oversight needed to shape the internship experiences so that significant learning opportunities are produced.

In addition to managing outlined projects, interns will also participate in a variety of educational opportunities including:

- Participation in various department, client and insurance company partnership meetings to gain a better understanding of the industry
- Exposure to current legislative changes affecting the industry
- Participation in “Mahowald Cares” community engagement
- Access and engagement with Senior Management and Agency Owners
